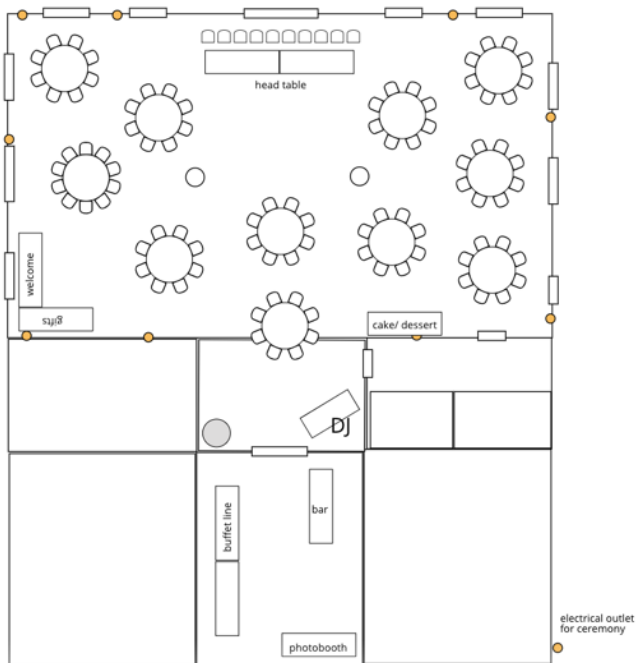
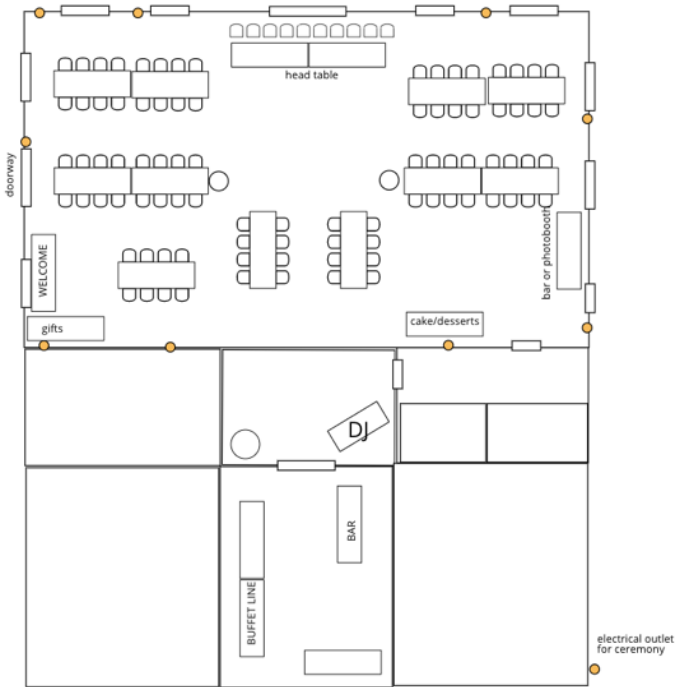
TIPS FOR GREAT FLOW AND LAYOUT

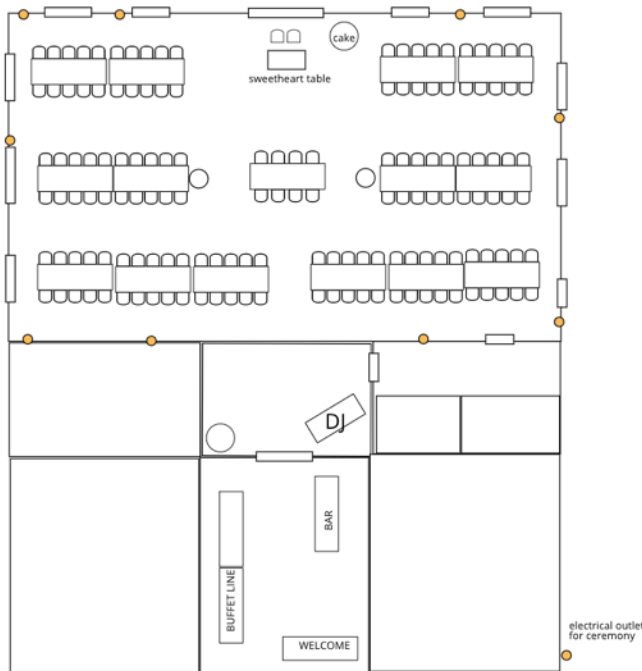
- Don't forget our capacity is a max of 150 people
- The dance floor area should be small, people feel more comfortable letting loose if the dancing area feels packed
- Our garage area with horse stalls is a great place for cocktail hour,
- When making your layout, be careful to not position the table where the couple or person of honor sits with windows to their back, or there will be flash and glare in the photos
- There are many room layout creators online and free! Make sure to use these tools to plan well or use the blank page in the back to hand draw a layout
- Make sure you leave plenty of room between tables, guests still have to pull chairs out and sit in the chairs, which you don't see in a layout creator
- If you are short on space, considering talking to your DJ about setting up on the loft overlooking the Great Room
- When making your layout, try your best to set up tables in such a way that all guests can see the couple or person of honor
- Ideally you should have at least two tables in your welcome area for guest book, gifts, and/or seating chart
- Make sure to review the full room dimensions at the end of this document which details windows and doors

LAYOUTS FOR 98 PEOPLE

Why I like these layouts:

- They are set with 8 people to a table, which is ideal for guest comfort
- These options give you flexibility, you can go up to 10 people per table and/or take tables away if you want more/ less space
- There is more room to add another table across the front if you have a huge head table
- It is easy to reduce the head table to a sweetheart table if you prefer
- Our gorgeous wood doors are the backdrop for the head table which will be nice in photos
- Plenty of space for dancing and speeches in front of the head table
- Cake/ dessert table is against a beautiful wood accent wall
- The garage room is perfect for cocktail hour, Photo Booth, activities and even the bar
- If you prefer, you could put the bar in the corner where the DJ is and put the DJ in the loft



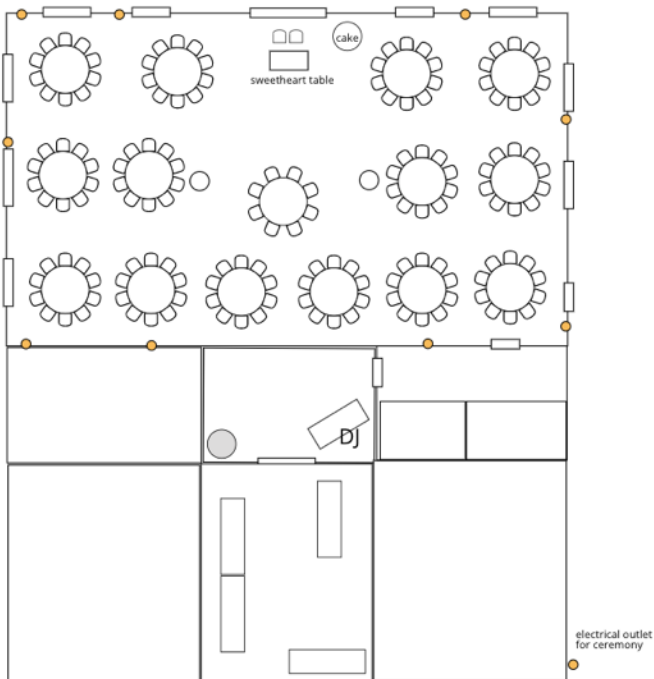


LAYOUTS FOR 120 to 150 PEOPLE

Drop either of these layouts down to 120 people by having only 8 chairs at a table, which would be more comfortable

Why I like this layout:

- Our big beautiful doors make a really nice photographic backdrop to the sweetheart table
- nice dancing area in front of the sweet heart table with cake off to the side and a reserved table for wedding party or parents here in the middle
- the garage area is a good place for cocktail hour. Open the doors and have indoor/outdoor space
- garage area is also a great space for the buffet line, bar, Photo Booth, welcome table and other activities
- Since this layout is really maxed out, you might consider putting the welcome and gift table outside in front of the main large wood door. It is protected here, blocks the front door where the sweetheart table is and is the first place guests see after parking
